Teenage Kicks School Code of Conduct

This leaflet outlines to pupils and parents/carers our expectations and guidelines for acceptable behaviour at Teenage Kicks School.

At Teenage Kicks School, all relationships are built upon courtesy and mutual respect.

We have high expectations of all our pupils. There are clear rules in place to ensure both the safety and welfare of all and to create an atmosphere which supports learning and achievement.

The Code of Conduct is in place to support pupils in managing their own learning and behaviour while allowing others to do the same.

To support pupils and enable them to maximise their chances of success at Teenage Kicks School, it is essential that the Code of Conduct is followed.

Failure to comply with the Code of Conduct, may result in your child being asked to leave, in which case a meeting will be convened at the school, in order to arrange for re-admission.

In the case of violence or possession of illegal substances or weapons, the Police will be informed and appropriate action taken.

Teenage Kicks Staff expect pupils to:

- > Arrive for 8:45am.
- Wear full Teenage Kicks School uniform at all times.
- Follow the requests of staff so that everyone is safe, happy and able to learn.
- In the event of lost learning time, the Headteacher reserves the right to request that time is made up on the same day. This can be up to one hour.
- ➤ Hand in outdoor coats and bags at reception along with mobile phones, headphones.
- > Do not bring vapes or cigarettes to school site.
- ➤ Bring suitable kit for PE i.e. Teenage Kicks t-shirt, tracksuit pants and training shoes.
- > To take care of the building and all equipment.

Please note:

- Smoking, including e-cigarettes is *not allowed* on site or in any of the grounds.
- ➤ Drugs and 'Legal Highs' *must not* be brought into school. Any pupil who arrives at school under the influence, or who is suspected of being under the influence of illegal substances will be sent home following contact with parents/carers.
- ➤ Any pupil found in possession of illegal substances or weapons will be reported to the Police which could result in permanent exclusion from Teenage Kicks School.
- Pupils may not leave the site unless they have permission from the Headteacher.
- ➤ In the event of damage being caused to the building, including deactivating security door systems, we reserve the right to charge parents/carers the cost of repairs or replacement of damaged goods or equipment.
